Climate Adaptation Assessment of Woningbouwimpuls Projects (2020-2022)

Executive summary

This report has assessed how climate adaptation has been embedded in the 93 housing development projects supported through the first three rounds (2020-2022) of the Dutch Woningbouwimpuls (WBI) programme. The assessment has been conducted to provide accountability to the European Commission and has focused on how climate adaptation has been secured through governance arrangements, project plans, municipal policies, and contractual agreements.

Because none of the projects has yet been completed and all projects have remained at different stages of the Dutch development process, the assessment has not evaluated realized outcomes. The analysis has therefore been based on four components: climate adaptation commitments included in WBI subsidy decisions, participation in regional climate adaptation covenants, municipal climate adaptation policies, and contractual arrangements between municipalities and developers.

The results have shown that climate adaptation has already been widely embedded in the early stages of project development. Of the 93 projects assessed, 82 projects (88%) have explicitly included climate adaptation measures in their WBI subsidy applications. These measures have most frequently addressed pluvial flooding (86%), followed by extreme heat (58%), fluvial flooding below 20 cm (54%), drought (48%), and nature-inclusive design (47%).

The analysis has also demonstrated substantial institutional support for climate adaptation. Seventy-seven percent of the assessed projects have been covered by at least one formal climate adaptation covenant.

Municipal policy has provided an important governance framework for implementation. Ninety-one percent of the assessed projects have been located in municipalities with an integrated climate adaptation policy, while the remaining projects have been supported through sectoral policies such as water management and green space strategies. Climate adaptation themes have been broadly represented in municipal policy, with pluvial flooding, heat stress and drought having received the greatest attention.

An in-depth review of contractual arrangements for eight projects has confirmed that climate adaptation requirements have been consistently addressed in agreements between municipalities and developers. In most cases, contracts have referred to climate adaptation objectives that have been established in programmes of requirements, policy documents or other planning instruments, and have ensured that these objectives have been carried forward into later development phases.

Overall, the assessment has concluded that climate adaptation has been structurally embedded within the WBI programme through a combination of legally binding subsidy commitments, policy frameworks, regional covenants and contractual arrangements. Although the projects have not yet been completed and implementation outcomes have therefore not been verified, the evidence collected has indicated that climate adaptation has been systematically integrated into governance and planning processes from the earliest stages of project development.

Managementsamenvatting (Dutch)

Dit rapport heeft beoordeeld hoe klimaatadaptatie is verankerd in de 93 woningbouwprojecten die zijn ondersteund via de eerste drie tranches (2020-2022) van het nationale Woningbouwimpuls (WBI) programma. De beoordeling is uitgevoerd ten behoeve van de verantwoording aan de Europese Commissie en heeft zich gericht op de wijze waarop klimaatadaptatie is geborgd via bestuurlijke afspraken, projectplannen, gemeentelijk beleid en contractuele afspraken.

Omdat geen van de projecten op dit moment is gerealiseerd en alle projecten zich in verschillende fasen van het Nederlandse gebiedsontwikkelingsproces bevinden, heeft deze beoordeling zich niet gericht op gerealiseerde resultaten. De analyse is daarom gebaseerd geweest op vier onderdelen: klimaatadaptatieverplichtingen in de WBI-beschikkingen, deelname aan regionale convenanten voor klimaatadaptief bouwen, gemeentelijk klimaatadaptatiebeleid en contractuele afspraken tussen gemeenten en ontwikkelaars.

De resultaten laten zien dat klimaatadaptatie al op grote schaal is geïntegreerd in de vroege fasen van projectontwikkeling. Van de 93 beoordeelde projecten hebben 82 projecten (88%) expliciete klimaatadaptatiemaatregelen opgenomen in hun WBI-aanvraag. Deze maatregelen hebben zich het vaakst gericht op wateroverlast door hevige neerslag (86%), gevolgd door hittestress (58%), overstromingen met een waterdiepte tot 20 cm (54%), droogte (48%) en natuurinclusief ontwerp (47%).

De analyse laat daarnaast zien dat er sprake is van een brede institutionele verankering van klimaatadaptatie. Zevenenzeventig procent van de projecten is onder ten minste één formeel convenant voor klimaatadaptief bouwen komen te vallen.

Gemeentelijk beleid vormt een belangrijk kader gevormd voor de uitvoering van klimaatadaptatie. Eenennegentig procent van de projecten is gelegen in gemeenten met een integraal klimaatadaptatiebeleid, terwijl de overige projecten zijn ondersteund door sectoraal beleid op het gebied van bijvoorbeeld waterbeheer en groenvoorzieningen. Klimaatadaptatiethema's zijn breed vertegenwoordigd in het gemeentelijk beleid, waarbij wateroverlast, hittestress en droogte de meeste aandacht hebben.

Een nadere analyse van de contractuele afspraken voor acht projecten heeft bevestigd dat klimaatadaptatie consequent is meegenomen in overeenkomsten tussen gemeenten en ontwikkelaars. In de meeste gevallen hebben deze overeenkomsten verwezen naar klimaatadaptatiedoelstellingen die zijn vastgelegd in programma's van eisen, beleidsdocumenten of andere planinstrumenten, en naar alle waarschijnlijkheid borgen dat deze doelstellingen worden meegenomen naar volgende fasen van de ontwikkeling.

Over het geheel genomen heeft deze beoordeling geconcludeerd dat klimaatadaptatie structureel is verankerd binnen het WBI-programma door een combinatie van juridisch bindende subsidieafspraken, beleidskaders, regionale convenanten en contractuele afspraken. Hoewel de projecten zich nog in de ontwikkelfase bevinden en de daadwerkelijke uitvoering nog niet kon worden vastgesteld, hebben de resultaten erop gewezen dat klimaatadaptatie vanaf de vroegste projectfasen onderdeel is geweest van de bestuurlijke en planologische processen en naar verwachting ook in de verdere uitvoering een belangrijke rol zal zijn blijven spelen.

2. Introduction

2.1 Background

Climate adaptation has become an increasingly important component of Dutch housing and urban development policy. The Woningbouwimpuls (WBI) programme supports housing developments throughout the Netherlands and includes climate adaptation commitments within project applications and subsidy decisions.

This report presents an analysis of how climate adaptation is embedded in the 93 WBI projects that were supported in the first three tranches (from 2020-2022).

The assessment examines governance arrangements, project-level climate adaptation measures and the relationship between projects and municipal policy frameworks.

The assessment is conducted to ensure accountability to the European Commission, which supports the Dutch Woningbouwimpuls (WBI) programme. The assessment was carried out by Arcadis on behalf of the Dutch Ministry of the Interior and Kingdom Relations (BZK).

2.2 Status of the WBI Projects

The 93 WBI projects have not yet been realised and are currently at different stages of the Dutch development process. Annex 1 shows the phasing of the development and construction process in the Netherlands. The phases are:

1. Initiation Phase

2. Feasibility Phase

a. Definition Phase

b. Design Phase

c. Preparation Phase

3. Realization Phase

4. Operation and Maintenance

The initiation phase examines the feasibility of a development and concludes with a tender or letter of intent in which climate objectives are defined. In the three sub phases of the feasibility phase requirements are selected on the basis of the project objectives (definition), and the extent to which the design meets these requirements and contributes to the overarching objectives is assessed (design and preparation).

Normally the contract with the builder is signed at the end of the definition phase and contains the information and/or references for the climate adaptation goals for the project.

2.3 Objectives and research questions

The main objective of this assessment is to establish a consistent, transparent and verifiable overview of how climate adaptation is incorporated in WBI projects. Therefore this report addresses the following research questions:

- how climate adaptation objectives are secured through agreements;
- which climate adaptation measures are applied;
- how these measures align with municipal policy.

3. Methodology

Since none of the 93 projects has yet been realised and they are currently at different stages of the Dutch development process, no single instrument can guarantee compliance with climate adaptation standards.

As noted, climate adaptation needs to be embedded through a combination of complementary governance instruments across the different phases of the Dutch development and construction process. In this context, the initiation phase, completed for all 93 projects, is a key predictor of whether climate adaptation is carried forward into subsequent phases.

The assessment is therefore based on four analytical components. First we assess the presence of climate adaptation themes as described in the WBI subsidy decisions (beschikking).

Second, the institutional embedding of climate adaptation will be analysed through participation in covenants between several provinces.

Third, for all municipalities included in the WBI programme, we assess the presence of thematic and integrated climate adaptation policies. We then analyse, for each WBI project, the extent to which the relevant themes are reflected in municipal policy.

In fourth place, we analyse the received contracts between the municipality and the developer. Together, these components provide insight into both the governance context and the practical implementation of climate adaptation. We will discuss the relevance of this instrument in this chapter. The used data sources for these analyses can be found in annex 2.

Limitations

Due to the integrated nature of climate adaptation in urban development, several structural limitations apply:

- Climate measures are often embedded in overall urban design and serve multiple purposes.
- Financial documents generally do not allow for detailed attribution of costs to individual climate measures.
- Projects are at different stages of development, affecting data availability.

As a result, the assessment focuses on governance structures, applied measures, and alignment, rather than detailed financial verification.

3.1 The WBI subsidy decisions

The subsidy decision makes the commitments included in the approved WBI application legally binding for the recipient municipality. This applies to all 93 projects assessed. Each project is assessed on the presence of climate adaptation measures as described in the WBI subsidy application.

Six thematic areas are distinguished:

- Pluvial flooding
- Drought
- Extreme heat
- Nature-inclusive design
- Fluvial flooding (< 20 cm)
- Fluvial flooding impact mitigation (> 20 cm)

For this assessment, coastal flooding is not included, because primary responsibility for coastal defense lies at national level and implementation is carried out by the central government (the State) and Rijkswaterstaat. As a result, coastal flood risk management measures are generally addressed through national programmes rather than within municipal policy frameworks or WBI project plans.

3.2 The selected covenants

At the time the first WBI projects were awarded, there were no national minimum standards for climate-adapted construction yet. Therefore, we looked at the existing agreements between provinces.

The covenants established agreements between municipalities, provinces, developers, housing associations, and water boards regarding minimum standards for climate-adapted construction. Provinces play a coordinating role in monitoring and evaluating these agreements. If a covenant has been signed, it can reasonably be assumed that the agreed minimum standards set of that covenant are being met in the WBI projects. The institutional embedding of climate adaptation is analyzed through participation in formal climate adaptation and sustainability covenants.

Two agreements between several provinces are included in the assessment:

Toekomstbestendig Bouwen

The Toekomstbestendig Bouwen agreement focuses on sustainable, climate-resilient, and future-proof construction. It was signed by the provinces of Zuid- Holland, Utrecht, Gelderland, Noord- Holland and Flevoland. It addresses themes such as a health living environment ,biodiversity, water management, heat stress, environmental quality, and long-term spatial resilience. The different minimum standards for climate adaptation for each province are discussed in de Leidraad Klimaatadaptief Bouwen. The covenant Toekomstbestendig Bouwen addresses this Leidraad Klimaatadaptief Bouwen.

Klimaatadaptief Bouwen

The different covenants Klimaatadaptief Bouwen t focuses on strengthening biodiversity and integrating nature into the built environment. It promotes ecological design, habitat creation, and climate-resilient green infrastructure. The provinces all have different covenants with a different set of minimum standards. The difference are adressed in the earlier mentioned Leidraad Klimaatadaptief Bouwen which is part of the collateral agreement Toekomstbestendig Bouwen

For each project, participation in these covenants is assessed at two administrative levels: provincial level and municipal level. Because urban development projects are implemented by municipalities, municipal participation is directly linked to project execution. Provincial participation indicates strategic and policy-level commitment, but does not automatically guarantee translation into local implementation. If both province and municipality have signed, this suggests strong vertical integration of climate ambitions. If only the province has signed, there is a risk that commitments are not fully translated into project practice, particularly if municipalities are not actively involved or informed.

In addition, an aggregated indicator shows whether at least one relevant covenant has been signed, by either the province or the municipality.

These indicators provide insight into the extent to which climate adaptation is institutionally secured within the governance structure of each project.

3.3 Municipal Policy

For each project, the relevant municipal integrated climate adaptation policy and the different climate adaptation themes will be identified. This includes, for example, climate strategies or implementation agendas. If a municipality does not have integrated climate adaptation (publicly) available, we will look at sectoral related policies; such as water, greenery and municipal land use policies. We can assume that every municipality has sectoral related policies because water and greenery are legally obliged municipality tasks. This step establishes the formal policy context within which the project is developed.

After the identification of the relevant municipal policies, we will then analyse, for each WBI project, the extent to which the relevant climate adaptation themes are reflected in municipal policy using the indicators 1 (true) and 0 (false)

3.4 Contractual Arrangements

Municipalities and developers frequently use contracts, development agreements or purchase agreements to further secure climate adaptation requirements under private law. For eight projects we received contractual arrangements. These were analyzed in detail to assess this mechanism.

Consequently, signing a covenant is not considered proof on its own that a project meets climate adaptation requirements, nor is the absence of a covenant interpreted as evidence that a project does not meet those requirements.

4. Results

This section provides an overview of the main findings derived from the research. The results can be found in the WBI Climate Adaptation Assessment Table (Annex 3). This chapter summarizes the most important results

4.1 General Project Characteristics

The 93 assessed projects are located across 10 provinces and 61 municipalities. The largest amount of projects are found in Zuid-Holland (28 projects) and Noord-Holland (21 projects). At municipal level, most projects are located in Den Haag (6 projects), followed by Eindhoven (5 projects), and Amsterdam and Leiden (4 projects each).

This variation affects the level of detail and the degree to which climate adaptation measures are already fixed in project designs.

4.2 Climate Adaptation measures in the WBI subsidy decisions

The occurrence of climate adaptation measures in the WBI subsidy decisions is shown below:

Of the 93 subsidy applications, 82 describe climate adaptation measures explicitly. These measures fall within the risk domains covered by the covenants and address on average three to four of the six domains assessed

4.3 Institutional Embedding Through Covenants

Table two shows that the large majority of projects (72%) is covered by at least one covenant, indicating broad support for climate adaptation. At the same time, 23% operate without formal participation in either agreement, implying a more limited support. Projects with both provincial and municipal participation (40%) show the strongest support, although this represents a smaller share than the total group covered by at least one covenant.

4.4 Municipal policy on climate adaptation

Table 3 shows that most WBI projects (85 projects, or 91%) are located in municipalities with a defined integrated climate adaptation policy. The remaining 8 projects (9%) are in municipalities without a specific climate policy, but with sectoral related policies in place.

Table 4 shows that municipal policies cover on average four of the six climate adaptation themes, and nine municipalities cover all six themes. This shows that most municipalities also cover climate adaptation themes that they are not legally obliged to, but gaps remains.

Table 5 shows that all WBI projects, are covered by one or more formal municipal thematic climate adaptation policies. The strongest alignment is observed for pluvial flooding, while fluvial flooding <20 cm shows the weakest alignment.

4.5 Analysis of Contractual Embedding

In annex 4 the results of the analysis of eight projects is given. This analysis examines how climate adaptation requirements are addressed in the received contractual agreements for various area developments. The focus is on identifying how climate adaptation is incorporated into legal documents, such as anterior agreements and purchase agreements, and how these requirements are linked to local climate adaptation policies.

Based on this analysis, it can be concluded that climate adaptation is addressed in all the contracts reviewed. In most cases, the contract refers to compliance with climate adaptation principles or objectives that are specified in other documents, such as an urban program of requirements. Frequently, there is also a reference to the incorporation of these objectives and/or principles into subsequent planning phases.

Furthermore, the analysis demonstrates that the absence of local climate adaptation policy for new developments does not necessarily mean that climate adaptation is not addressed within the planning process. In some cases, climate adaptation requirements are included in the contracts even when no specific local policy existed at the time. This indicates a varied approach in the formal embedding of climate adaptation within contractual frameworks.

5. Conclusion

The results suggest that climate adaptation is structurally embedded in most WBI projects through a combination of covenants, policy frameworks, and project plans.

The strong focus on pluvial flooding reflects regional and local priorities. However, drought and biodiversity are less consistently addressed, indicating potential areas for further development.

Key numbers

- 77% of projects is committed via at least one covenant.
- 40% of projects is committed via both provincial and municipal level covenant.
- 100% of provinces have policy on climate adaptation.
- 86% of projects have measures on pluvial flooding, while only 47% of projects have measures on nature-inclusive design and only 11% on fluvial flooding >20cm.
- Strongest alignment is observed for pluvial flooding (86%), while fluvial flooding <20 cm (44%) shows the weakest alignment.
- 100% of the participating municipalities have local policies on pluvial flooding, and 97% on extreme heat

In the phasing of the Dutch development and construction process it is common that climate adaptation requirements are part of every phase. In the assessment of eight projects, it was concluded that climate adaptation is addressed in all the reviewed documents.

Dutch context: national, local climate policy and regional housing agreements

Some of the results and statistics in the table can be explained by national policies and how they have been translated at the municipal level. One of the first concrete national policies on climate adaptation was the Delta Decision (Deltabeslissing) in 2014. The Delta Decision stated that the Netherlands needs to be climate-proof by 2050. In order to achieve that, climate adaptation needed to be included in (local) policies and spatial developments by 2020. To make these goals more concrete and attainable the Delta Programme for Spatial Adaptation (DPRA) was published in 2018. It formulates seven steps / ambitions that all governments – including municipalities – are working on in cyclic process. The first cycle started in 2018, the second started in 2024. Within the cycle, municipalities must write down ambitions, strategy and actions in climate adaptation plans.

The focus of municipalities is mostly on pluvial flooding, heat stress and drought. Policies and measures related to water and sewage systems are well documented, since municipalities have been obligated to report and maintain their municipal water- and sewage systems since the 1990s. Heat stress and drought, however, have only gained more attention recently due to increasingly warm summers and extreme drought in 2018. Responsibilities and actions related to fluvial flooding and coastal flooding lie largely with other public authorities and are therefore not consistently reflected in municipal policy documents. For this assessment, coastal flooding is not included, because primary responsibility for coastal defense lies at national level and implementation is carried out by the central government (the State) and Rijkswaterstaat. As a result, coastal flood risk management measures are generally addressed through national programmes rather than within municipal policy frameworks or WBI project plans.

Therefore, it is not surprising that the projects and municipality policies score high on pluvial flooding and low for fluvial and coastal flooding since it is covered by other governmental bodies.

Another explanation can be found in de woondeal. Every municipality participating in the WBI programme has concluded a woondeal with the national government. The woondeals confirm that climate adaptive construction forms part of the regional housing programming. They do not restate the individual measures of each subsidy application. Climate adaptive construction is increasingly included in these agreements, which reflects the growing anchoring of the theme within the housing policy domain and its associated stakeholder framework.

Disclaimers

The results are based on the information available online at the time of research/publication (March 2026). Some municipalities do not make their documentation and contracts fully publicly available and therefore have not been included in the excel table.

Annex 1

Phasing of the Dutch development and construction process



In the Netherlands, the development and construction process can be divided into the following phases:

1. Initiation Phase:

This phase examines the feasibility of a development and concludes with a tender or letter of intent in which climate objectives are defined.

2. Feasibility Phase:

This phase consists of three sub-phases:

- a. Definition Phase: Establishes the spatial framework for the development.
- b. Design Phase: Translates the development into a concrete design.
- c. Preparation Phase: Focuses on detailed design and contracting for the realization phase.

During the definition phase, requirements are selected on the basis of the project objectives. During the design and preparation phases, the extent to which the design meets these requirements and contributes to the overarching objectives is assessed.

3. Realization Phase:

This phase involves the actual construction of the development.

4. Operation and Maintenance:

In this phase, the completed development is occupied, used, and maintained.

Annex 4

Analysis received information projects on climate adaptation



Poort van Hoorn – Municipality of Hoorn

The received annex to the anterior agreement contains a guidance on sustainable building and an analysis of climate adaptation of the plan area based on these principles. From this analysis a number of measure packages emerge to meet these principles. The principles largely correspond with the regional covenant on climate-adaptive building.

Groene Heerlijkheid – Municipality of Deurne

The Municipality of Deurne has no spatial policy and/or signed regional covenant regarding climate-adaptive requirements for new construction.

The anterior agreement refers to the conditions set out in the layout plan for the development of the public space. The layout plan is in turn based on the municipality of Deurne's public space manual. The layout plan sets out principles in the area of the water task and the design of the green infrastructure.

In addition, the anterior agreement states that the developer must compensate existing greenery by means of a green compensation plan and/or a financial payment. Furthermore, the anterior agreement states that the developer must guarantee the greenery, including planting, up to one year after final delivery.

Stadshavens – Municipality of Groningen

We did not receive an anterior agreement but we did receive a council proposal for the signing of the cooperation agreement which will form the basis for several anterior agreements with the involved landowners.

The 2022 cooperation agreement includes the following:
As part of the spatial plan and the environment impact assessment, further research will be carried out into the way in which already established municipal ambitions in the areas of greenery, mobility, ecology, sustainability and quality of life will be realized. In 2022 the Municipality of Groningen had an implementation agenda for climate adaptation with guidelines for heat, inundation and drought. This was used together with the public space guideline as a design guideline. As of 2026 the Municipality of Groningen has more concrete policy such as the policy framework Nature-Inclusive Building (2024) and the environmental program Green Standards (2025).

Zaanstad Noord – Municipality of Zaanstad

For the area development of Zaanstad Noord we did not receive an anterior agreement. We did receive the signed process agreements for the development of building initiatives. These state that a preliminary design must be worked out which includes a substantiation with regard to compliance with the guidelines included in the regional covenant on climate-adaptive building. The preliminary design also requires the execution of a number of calculations demonstrating that the principles are met (for example regarding the realization of tree canopy cover 20 years after planting).

In addition to the preliminary design, requirements are also specified for progression towards the definitive design and the execution design.

Development zone Oostpoort (plot 1F), Municipality of Haarlem

We did not receive an anterior agreement but we did receive the purchase agreement of plot 1F. This agreement states that the building plan and (semi) public space plan must fit within the sustainability ambitions as included in the urban design program of requirements. The purchase agreement focuses on one part of the plan area. The total area development is therefore broader than this purchase agreement. The purchase agreement explicitly states that a green (habitable) roof must be realized. The urban program of requirements contains requirements relating to water compensation, ecology, and retention of existing water structures. It is also agreed that developing parties will prepare a green paragraph.

Both the purchase agreement and the urban design plan do not refer to municipal policy regarding climate adaptation or regional covenant.

Spoorzone – part Lingehoven and Veilingterrein – Municipality of Tiel

Compliance with the area vision is included in the agreement with the developing parties for two of the three subareas within the Spoorzone. These concern the Veilingterrein and the Teisterbantlaan. The area vision addresses climate adaptation but these principles are limited to research into which materials can be used to reduce heat stress.

Overvecht South 1st phase De Mix, – Municipality of Utrecht

The anterior agreement states that the developing party must prepare a layout plan for the public space in which the municipality's frameworks are applied. One of these frameworks is the public space manual. The frameworks are assessed by the established committee for management, layout and use. The municipality ultimately adopts the layout plan. Also the building plan is prepared according to the urban program of requirements. This contains a sustainability paragraph with rules on water management, heat stress and greenery.

Galgeriet / Gouwhaven, Municipality of Waterland

The purchase agreement refers to the Galgeriet Sustainability Regulations 2019. This policy contains rules regarding stormwater and soil care and heat stress. In addition, the developer must comply with the established layout plan and image quality plan concerning greenery and water management.

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
